Status of Interreg VI-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme

- 10 projects, with a total value of approx. 52 million euro, have been contracted in 2024, in different domains, such as:

Priority 1: A well connected region:

- operation of strategic importance “DISMAR- Danube Integrated System for MARking”, with a total value of approx. 10 million euro

Priority 2- A greener region:

- operation of strategic importance “Streamlining cross-border cooperation: Joint approach in disaster resilience” (STREAM 2), with a total budget of approx. 24 million euro
- 8 regular projects with a total value of approx. 18 million euro

- 2 regular projects with a total value of approx. 6 million euro are currently in analysis, in the pre-contracting phase, most likely will be contracted in 2025



Status of Interreg VI-A Romania-Bulgaria Programme

During 2024, two competitive calls for projects were launched:



1. Call 3 - Call dedicated to operations under Priority 3, Policy Objective 4, SO 4.2 - Improving equal access to inclusive and quality services in education, training and lifelong learning through developing accessible infrastructure, including by fostering resilience for distance and on-line education and training, launched on 7th of May 2024 with a deadline for submission of 9th of September 2024 (assessment on going)

2. Call 4 - Competitive call for project proposals dedicated to Priority 2: A Green Region, Specific Objectives 2.4 - Promoting climate change adaptation and disaster risk prevention, resilience taking into account eco-system based approaches – climate change adaptation, launched on 18th of October 2024, with a deadline for submission of 17th of February 2025



The Integrated Territorial Strategy for the development of Romania Bulgaria Cross Border Area was approved during the 4th meeting of the Strategy Board, on the 3rd of June 2024.
